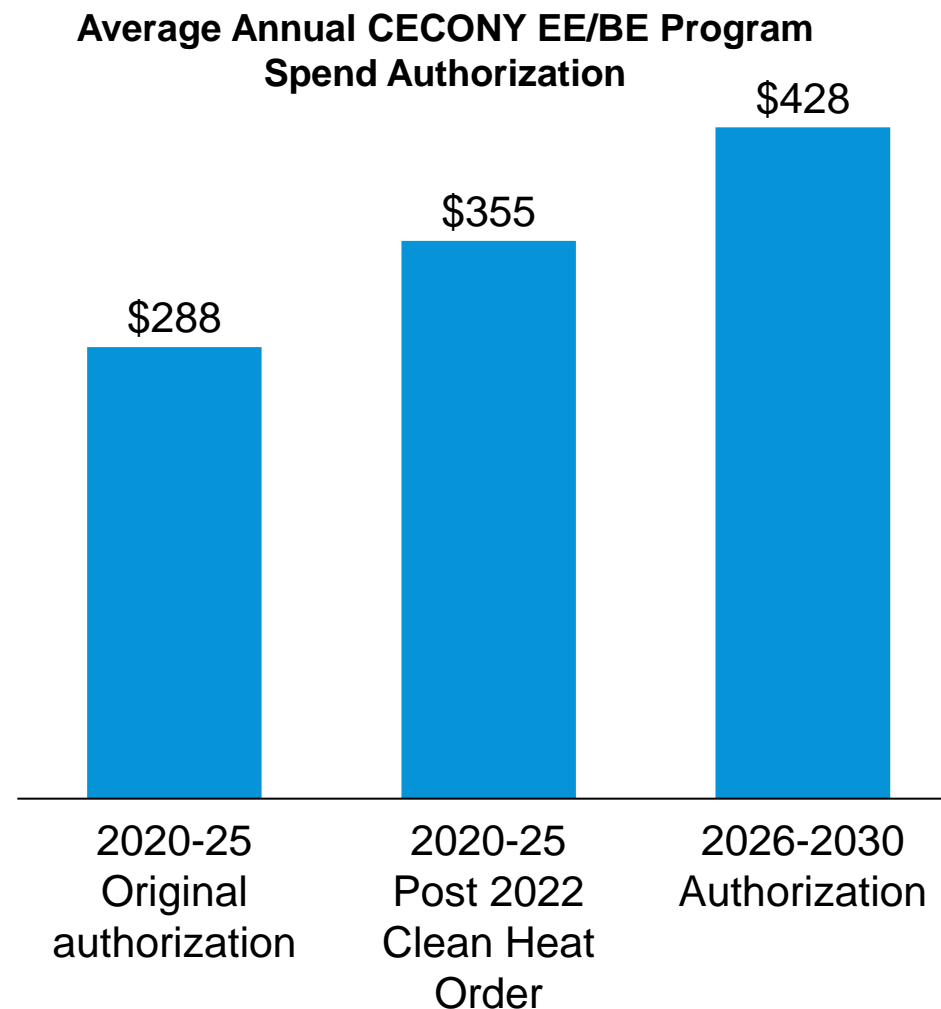

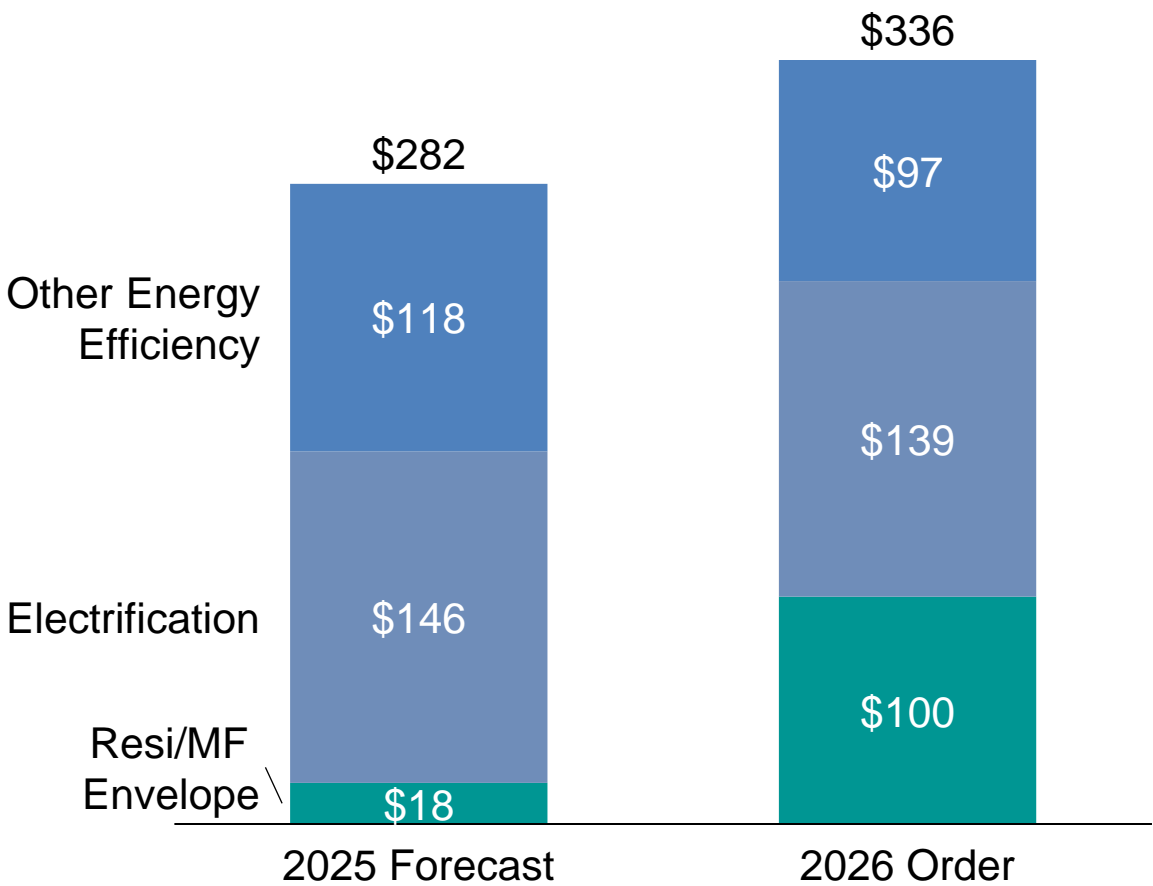
# Overview of Energy Efficiency / Building Electrification Orders

- On May 15, NYS Public Service Commission (PSC) issued orders ([Non-LMI](#) and [LMI](#)) authorized \$5.36B statewide for the utility Energy Efficiency and Building Electrification (EE/BE) program from 2026-2030.
- The EE/BE Orders:
  - Authorize over \$2.1B over five years for Con Edison
  - Secure building electrification funding through 2030
  - Change the branding of building electrification programs
    - “Clean Heat” will refer only to the residential (1-4 family) BE Program
    - Non-Residential customer segments moved into Core Programs
- Con Edison is developing program specifics for ‘26-30 period.
  - More outreach and engagement to come!



# Orders Prioritize Weatherization and Electrification

CECONY Non-LMI EE/BE Portfolio by Measure Type



- The EE/BE Orders roughly maintain building electrification spending from 2025 through in 2026-2030.
- The EE/BE Orders mandated significant growth in weatherization

# 2026-30 EE/BE Portfolio Next Steps

- In compliance with the May 15 orders from the PSC, Con Edison will submit Implementation Plans (IPs) that will begin outlining the building framework for Residential and Non-Residential customer segments.
- The schedule for Implementation Plans impacting Building Electrification are summarized below

Filing Deadline	Description	Approving Entity
July 14, 2025	Non-LMI EE/BE IP	Department of Public Safety (DPS)
August 13, 2025	Upstate and Downstate Joint Utilities' Filings for proposals for Regional Weatherization Programs (1-4 family and multifamily for CECONY)	PSC
September 1, 2025	Clean Heat IP	DPS
September 12, 2025	Con Edison, National Grid and NYSERDA file a joint LMI IP	DPS

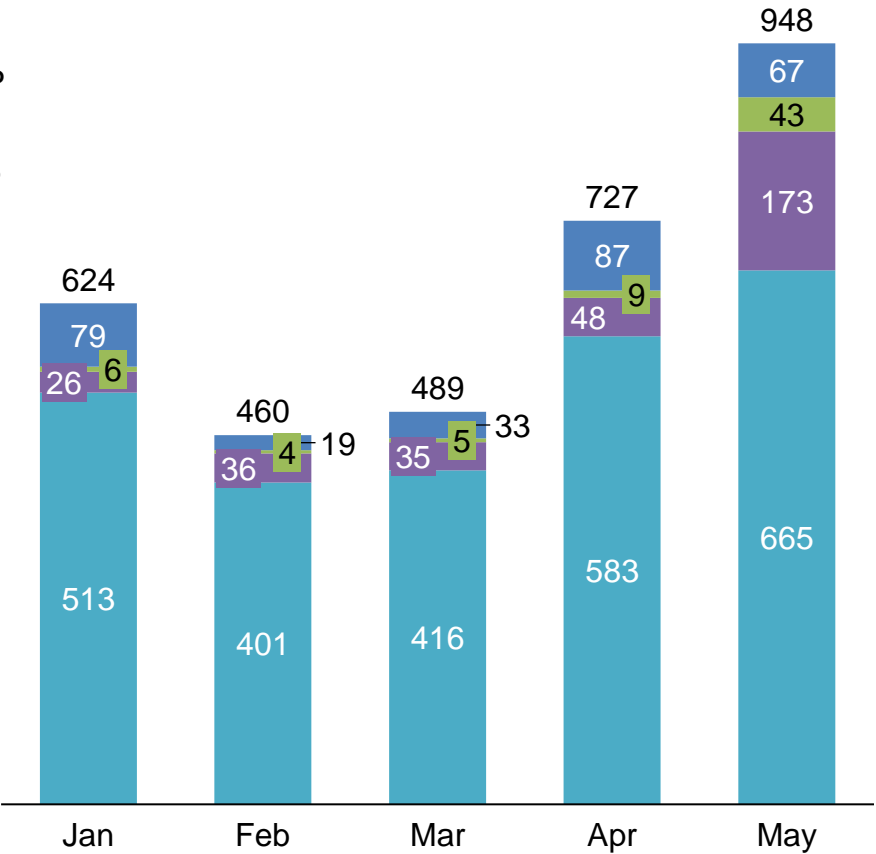

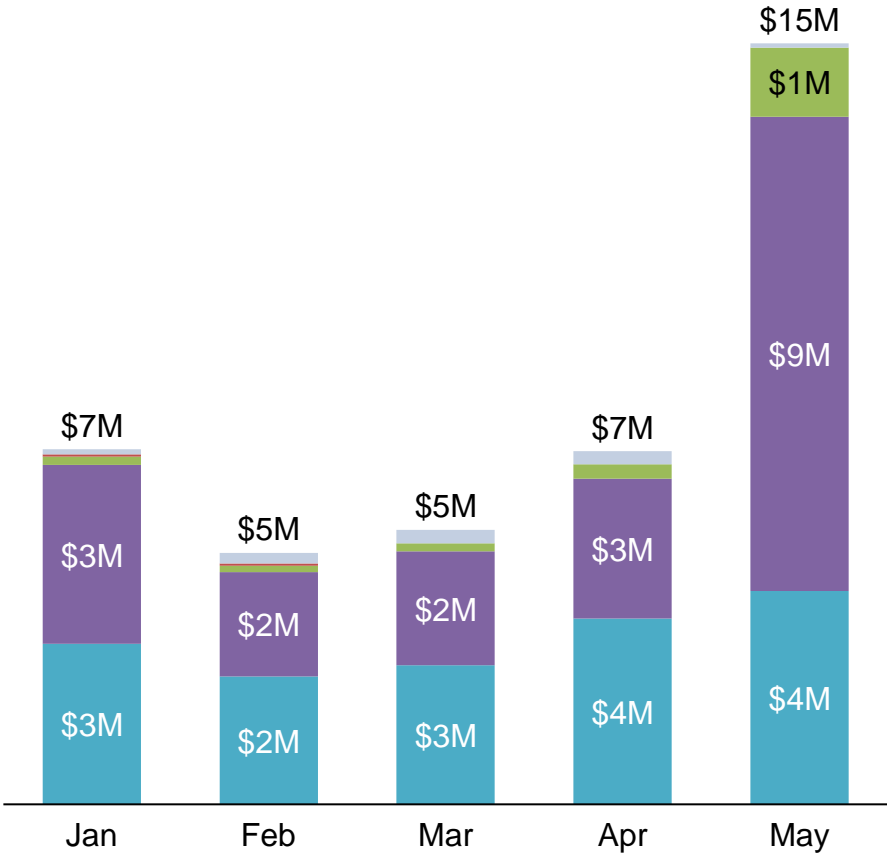
# Clean Heat Program Achievement & Budget

Incentives committed against the Continuity Funding Mechanism

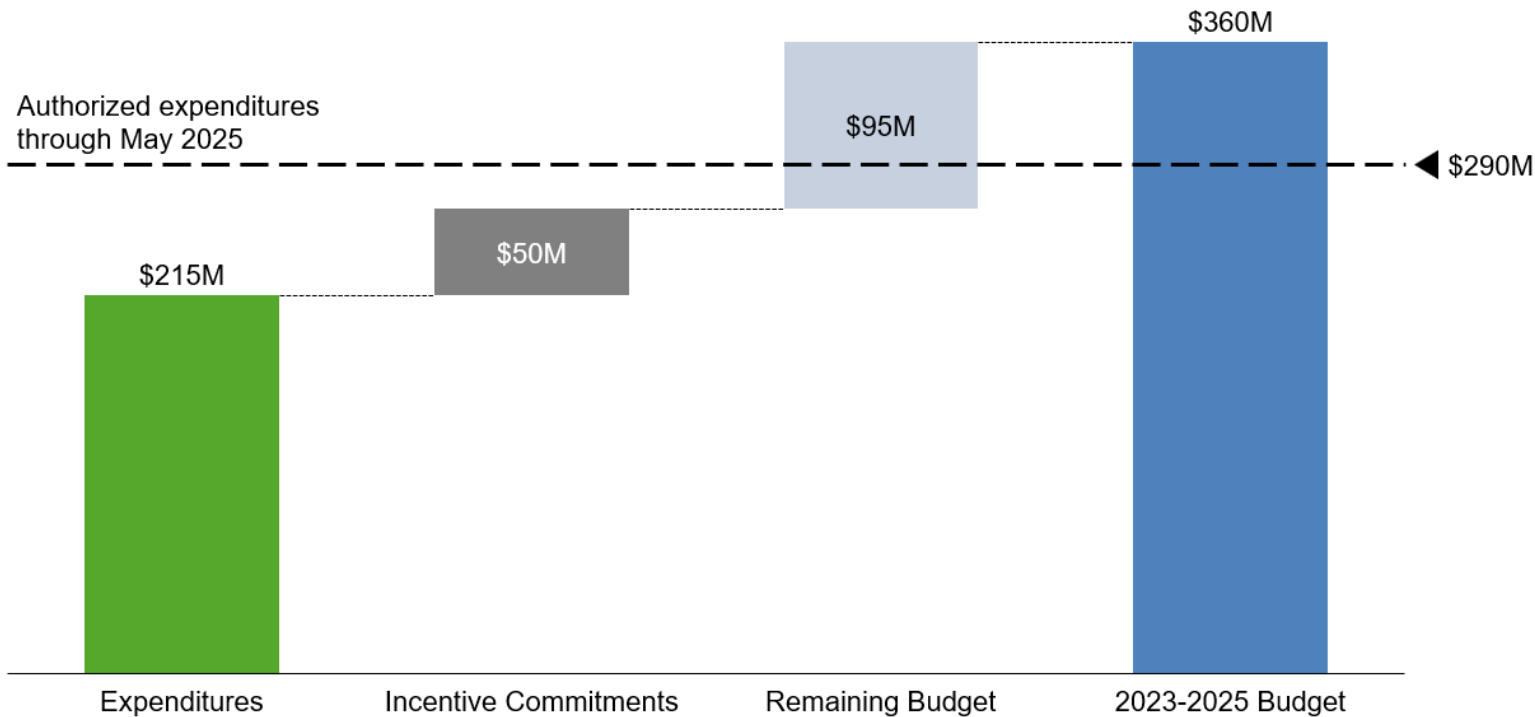




# Con Edison Clean Heat Program Budget Status

Con Edison has authorization for a three-year budget of \$360M with expenditures for completed projects limited to \$10M each month for the Clean Heat Program

2023-2025 Con Edison Clean Heat Budget Summary As of June 1, 2025



**Expenditures:** Program spend for completed projects  
**Incentive Commitments:** Funds reserved for projects with submitted applications and/or issued Preliminary Incentive Offer Letters  
**Remaining Budget:** Remaining authorized program funding through 2025 for incentives and program implementation

# June 2, 2025, Con Edison Program Manual Update

Key changes are summarized below, and all changes are included in a Summary of Changes table at the beginning of the June 2 Program Manual.

- End of Limited Time Offers (LTOs):
  - LTOs for Residential Ground Source Heat Pump (GSHP), Multifamily, Commercial, and Industrial projects ended on May 31, 2025
  - LTO for Small Biz Air Source Heat Pump (ASHP) projects ends June 30, 2025.
- Residential GSHP projects with applications received in 2025, can be installed by November 30, 2026.
- Small Biz applications, following the expedited process for prescriptive Category 2d projects, must be submitted within 30 days of installation.
- The Packaged Window Heat Pump (PWHP) Demonstration Program section was revised to highlight NYSERDA and Con Edison's joint efforts in incentivizing PWHP. NYSERDA will provide pilot details soon.

# ASHP Residential Contractor Allocations

- Contractors received Q3 2025 allocations on Tuesday, June 10, 2025.
- Contractors should only submit applications for incentives within their allocated incentive budget.
- Contractors are encouraged to reach out to their account manager to request additional funding for projects beyond their allocation prior to installation.
- Contractors who sell projects above their allocation may have those projects placed on a waitlist or access to the Online Intake Tool (OIT) disabled
