

# **Application Intake – Incentives (\$M)**

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### **2025 Commercial Limited Time Offer**

- Effective December 4, 2024, Con Edison announced increased incentives as a part of a 2025
   Commercial Limited Time Offer ("2025 Commercial LTO")
- Only custom air source heat pump projects for space and water heating in the Small Biz and C&I sectors are eligible for 2025 Commercial LTO incentive rates
- Program documentation and calculator tools will be updated by December 20, including:
  - Con Edison Clean Heat Program Manual
  - Statewide CHP Custom Calculator
  - Category 6 Domestic Hot Water Calculator

## **Small Biz 2025 LTO for Custom ASHP Projects**

To be eligible for 2025 Commercial LTO, custom Small Biz projects must meet the following deadlines:

- Submit applications after December 4, 2024, and by May 31, 2025
- Installed with final completion documents submitted by September 19, 2025
- Pass post-inspection by October 31, 2025

Small Biz projects submitted during the 2025 Commercial LTO have a project cost cap of \$400,000.

## **C&I 2025 LTO for ASHP Projects**

To be eligible for 2025 Commercial LTO, C&I projects must meet the following deadlines:

- Submit applications after December 4, 2024, and by April 1, 2025
- Installed with final completion documents submitted by July 31, 2025
- Pass post-inspection by August 29, 2025

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## **ASHP Residential Contractor Allocation Funding Pool**

- Beginning Q1 2025, to improve the contractor experience and more effectively manage the Clean Heat budget, Con Edison will take a streamlined approach to Contractor Allocations
- Each month, Con Edison will dedicate some of its existing Clean Heat budget to support new contractors and those who have historically submitted less than three projects per month via a "Funding Pool"
- Contractors in the Funding Pool do not need to submit allocation requests
- A contractor in the Funding Pool who wishes to submit more than three projects in a month should contact their account manager
- The Con Edison Clean Heat Program will provide regular updates to Contractors in the Funding Pool on its remaining budget

## **ASHP Residential Contractor Allocations**

- Contractors received Q1 2025 allocations on Monday, December 10, 2024.
- Contractors may only submit applications for incentives within their allocated incentive budget.
- Contractors are encouraged to reach out to their account manager to request additional funding for projects beyond their allocation prior to installation.
- Contractors who sell projects above their allocation risk those projects being ineligible for incentives or temporarily losing access to submit new applications.

## Misrepresentation on Residential Projects

The Con Edison ASHP Residential Clean Heat Program disciplinary process introduced on October 15 includes performance on projects and Misrepresentations

- Misrepresentation describes an effort by a contractor to mislead the Program.
- Possible Misrepresentation describes the time when the program suspects Misrepresentation.
- Examples of Misrepresentation may include:
  - Providing false or misleading information
  - Failing to appropriately apply project incentives
  - Refusing to respond or responding improperly to program inquiries
- If a Contractor does not respond to program inquiries regarding Possible Misrepresentation within one week, or
  otherwise impedes efforts to investigate a Possible Misrepresentation, the Program may treat that episode as a
  Confirmed Misrepresentation.
- Confirmed Misrepresentations may result in disciplinary actions as deemed appropriated by the program




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## **Multifamily System Sizing Requirements Reminder**

- System sizing requirements per the Con Edison Clean Heat Program Manual (Section 3.2.1)
  - Projects with equipment sized greater than 120% of the Building Heating Load, are required to submit system sizing justification letters.
  - Projects with equipment sized greater than 115% of the Building Cooling Load may trigger the need for system sizing justification letters.

- Required system sizing justification letters must be submitted with the project application and shall include:
  - Explanation for the system oversizing from the participating contractor or the project design engineer
  - Any applicable information that supports the need for system oversizing
    - Examples: sizing calculations, specification or technical data sheets (cutsheets), etc.
